

## TOURNAMENT CONDITIONS

### [Lodgement of an entry will be considered as acceptance of these conditions]

- 1 Other than where exceptions are provided within these Tournament Conditions (below), the tournament will be held under TTQ and ITTF rules and regulations.
- 2 Entries can only be accepted from **current, appropriately-registered players** of an Association affiliated with TTQ and / or TTA. Proof of current Registration may be requested.
- 3 Matches in the semi-finals and Finals of Events 1 & 2 (ie, the two Open Singles events) are to be played as the best of seven, 11 point games. All other matches are the best of five, 11 point games.
- 4 Subject to the number of entries in an event, round robins and / or knockout draws may be used.
- 5 Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the Tournament Committee.
- 6 **Entries will be accepted until 8pm, Monday 21/5/2018.** Please lodge entries as early as possible.
- 7 The decision of the Referee will be final on any point of law. An umpire whose decision will be final on a point of fact shall be appointed to control each match.
- 8 Event format; Seeding and Rating/grading; and the acceptance of any entry shall be at the discretion of the Tournament Committee, with *ratingscentral.com* used as a reference. Note that Rating/grading for Doubles events will be based on the average rating of the pair of players.
- 9 Women players who enter the Open Singles event (Event 1) must also enter the Women's Open Singles event (Event 2).
- 10 All players are expected to be available to umpire matches when asked to do so. This may be prior to competing in a particular event.
- 11 Players not available to play when called upon can be liable to disqualification from an event.
- 12 Players participate at their own risk and no claim for injury will be recognised.
- 13 Any event with five or less entries may, at the discretion of the Tournament Committee, be cancelled or combined with another event without prior notification.
- 14 Players may enter any event for which they are eligible, although players from lower grades may be balloted out of higher grades where those events have large entry numbers.
- 15 **Players may not enter more than five (5) events on each day** (doubles and singles are counted as separate events). Also, **no player is to enter more than one (1) event with the same start time.**
- 16 Doubles players must ensure that their partner has submitted a separate entry form. If a partner is required, write "*PARTNER REQUIRED*" in space provided.
- 17 Entry fees must be paid in full on arrival at the centre before playing any event.
- 18 Bad language, offensive or unsportsmanlike behaviour or wilful damage will not be tolerated; with offenders liable to disqualification; the cost of necessary repairs; and/or any other sanctions if felt warranted by the Referee and/or the Organisers.
- 19 Dress regulations will be enforced; including non-marking shoes. During play, caps or other head wear; accessories and tracksuits may only be worn with the permission of a Referee.
- 20 AGE LIMITS Over 40, 50, 60 and 70 during 2018.  
Under 13, 15, 18 and 21 as at 1 January 2018.
- 21 Starting times are approximate. All players are requested to report to the Registration Desk upon arrival, at least 15 minutes prior to the scheduled starting time of the event.
- 22 **It is the responsibility of each player to ensure that their equipment is compliant with current regulations.** Coverings can only be attached to the blade with adhesives that do not contain harmful volatile solvents. Gluing or re-gluing of rackets is not permitted inside the hall.
- 23 **White colour, DHS 3 Star D40+ Table Tennis Balls** will be used. The primary colour of shirts, shorts and skirts shall be clearly different in colour to the ball.
- 24 The Tournament Committee reserves the right to alter starting times of events.
- 25 In events 1-5; 25 & 27, full Prize Money will be paid provided six or more players/pairs compete. If five or less players/pairs compete, only 50% of the advertised Prize Money will be paid.
